

## Visit of the Deputy CHOD of the State of Qatar to NATO



On 5 February 2014, the NATO Political Affairs and Security Policy Division organised a visit to NATO Headquarters of the Deputy CHOD of Qatar, Major General Thani Bin Jassim Al-Thani, and his accompanying delegation of high-ranking military officials, as well as the Ambassador of the State of Qatar to the Kingdom of Belgium, H.E. Sheikh Ali Bin Jassim Al-Thani, and the Defense Attaché at the Embassy of the State of Qatar to the Kingdom of Belgium, Brigadier Hadi Mohammed Al-Shahwani.

Topics discussed included NATO's Istanbul Cooperation Initiative; NATO's Current Political Agenda; Military Cooperation in the Framework of the Istanbul Cooperation Initiative; and NATO's Transformation and Outreach to the Middle East and the Gulf region.
